

Emergency Permits for Non-Divisible Loads

If you should have an OS/OW move that is considered an "Emergency" which is defined as:

"a calamity, existing or imminent caused by fire, flood, riot, windstorm, explosion, an act of God or a request from a public official which requires immediate remedial action to protect property or life."

Submit an Emergency OS/OW Permit via the NHDOT Permits system prior to contacting the Permit Office.
